Mr. Mull presented the same Preliminary Budget that was discussed at the Board meeting of May 17, 1988, the overall total being \$1,834,112.00.

After discussion, including comments and questions from the public, Chairman Smith announced that the Public Hearing was closed. Thereupon, Chairman Smith reconvened the regular monthly meeting at 2:10 p.m.

# 4. Consideration of Resolution Adopting the FY 1988 - 89 Operation & Maintenance Budget:

Mr. Boggs moved the adoption of the Resolution adopting the Operation and Maintenance Budget for FY 1988-89. This Resolution is attached herewith and made a part of these minutes. Mr. Williams seconded the motion, and roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

#### 5. REPORT OF ENGINEER-MANAGER:

#### a. Status of Phase III Plant Expansion Contracts:

Mr. Mull reported that progress is improving on Section 3 General Work, and Republic Contracting Corporation has billed the District for 6.5% of the contract.

There has been no significant change in the status of Section 3A Electrical. No on-site work has begun on Section 3A. The contractor, King Electric, Inc., has requested payment of \$99,718 for partial mobilization and stored materials for 9.2% of the contract.

For Section 3B HVAC, this project was readvertised on May 2, 1988, and bids were received on June 7, 1988. Two bids were received. The apparent low bidder is Martin Heating and Air Conditioning, Inc. of Hendersonville, with a total bid of \$133,964.00. Asheville Heating and Cooling, Inc. presented a bid which totaled \$142,200.00. It is the recommendation of Hendon Engineering Associates, Inc. that this bid be tentatively awarded to Martin Heating and Air Conditioning, Inc., in the amount of \$133,964.00, subject to approval of the North Carolina Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Environmental Management, and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

For Section 3C Plumbing, this project was readvertised on May 2, 1988, and bids were received on June 7, 1988. One bid was received from Price Piping, Inc. totaling \$198,440.00. It is the recommendation of Hendon Engineering Associates, Inc., that the bid be tentatively awarded to Price Piping, Inc., in the amount of \$198,440.00, subject to negotiations with Price Piping, Inc., following analysis of cost summary by Hendon Engineering and the Engineer-Manager, not to exceed \$198,440.00, and approval of the North Carolina Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Environmental Management, and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The bids for Section 3B HVAC and Section 3C Plumbing were reviewed by Mr. Walter Currie, General Counsel, and found to be in acceptable form, with the exception the copy of the bid bond from Price Piping, Inc. did not bear the corporate seal of the surety.

### b. Consideration of Resolutions for Tentative Award of Bids for Phase III Main Plant Expansion, Section 3B HVAC, and Section 3C Plumbing:

 $\mbox{\rm Mr.}$  Currie reviewed the Resolution for Section 3B with the Board.

Mr. Currie stated there is a bill pending before the Legislature in the short session which would allow Boards such as the MSD, the option of going with a single contract versus multiple contracts. General discussion followed.

Mr. Waddey moved that the Board adopt a Resolution, attached hereto and made a part of these minutes, expressing its support for the proposed Amendment to General Statutes Section 143-128 allowing single contracts for construction of public construction projects. Mr. Aceto seconded the motion, and voice vote carried unanimously in favor of the motion.

Mr. Dent recommended that the Plant Expansion Committee meet with the Engineer-Manager, Consulting Engineers, and General Counsel when negotiations take place for Section 3C Plumbing, for the protection of the Board. Mr. Aceto seconded the motion, and voice vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Mr. Batts seconded the motion, and roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion. A copy of the Resolution is attached herewith and made a part of these minutes.

# c. Consideration of Requests to Attend WPCF Conference:

Mr. Mull requested that the Board authorize any Board members who wish to attend, along with the Engineer-Manager and his staff, to attend the Water Pollution Control Federation (WPCF) Conference in Dallas, Texas, October 3 thru 6, 1988.

Mr. Boggs moved that the Board authorize any Board members, the Engineer-Manager and his staff to attend the WPCF Conference October 3 - 6, 1988, in accordance with the policy previously set forth. Mr. Edwards seconded the motion. Roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

# d. Status Report on Preliminary Discussions to Improve Septage Handling Situation:

Mr. Mull reported that June 13, 1988, he, Bill Morris and Jim Stokoe had a meeting to discuss septage/grease, and reviewed the results of their meeting with the Board. Lengthy discussion followed.

# e. Status of Proposed Sludge Disposal Facilities (Phase IV, Plant Expansion:

Mr. Mull reported that the District has not heard anything from the EPA concerning this project.

# (1) Selection of Audit Firm for 1988-'89 Audit:

Mr. Batts reported the Budget Committee met on May 24, 1988 to interview audit firms who had submitted a proposal for services to the District. It is the recommendation of the

Budget Committee that Mohnkern, Bolick & Company be selected to perform the FY 1987-88 audit for the District, and that Mohnkern, Bolick & Company be engaged on the basis of a firm quotation to develop for MSD a policies and procedures manual and a comprehensive chart of accounts, after the audit is completed, all at a cost not to exceed \$9,900.00. Mr. Dyson moved that the Board accept the recommendation of the Budget Committee and Mr. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

### b. Personnel Committee - Mr. Ivey

# (1) Consideration of Request to Engage Land-Of-Sky to Prepare Personnel Policy Manual for MSD:

Mr. Mull gave a report for the Personnel Committee in Mr. Ivey's absence. The Personnel Committee met on June 20, 1988, with Mr. Jim Carter and Mrs. Jane Miller from the Land-Of-Sky Regional Council, to discuss the preparation of a personnel policy manual for the District. After general discussion, Mr. Batts moved that the District engage the Land-Of-Sky Regional Council to prepare a personnel policy manual for the District, at a cost not to exceed \$3,700.00. Mr. Waddey seconded the motion, and roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

### c. Sewer Service Charge & Sewer Rate Review - Mr. Boggs

Mr. Boggs reported that the Sewer Service Charge and Sewer Rate Review Committees met on June 7, 1988, to consider reductions in sewer charges for lawn watering, etc. The Committee recommends no change in the current policy. No action was taken on this issue.

### d. Sewer System Consolidation Committee - Mr. Aceto

Mr. Aceto reported that the Sewer System Consolidation Committee met in May with Mr. Jack Stevens and Mr. Bill Morris and Mr. Jim Stokoe to draft consolidation options for discussion and reviewed these options with the Board. Mr. Aceto stated he has received a letter from Mr. Doug Bean, City Manager, suggesting the City of Asheville would favorably entertain a proposal based on one of two options. One option being that MSD take over the entire system immediately, as MSD has proposed, and that MSD assume all responsibility for constructing the extensions that the City would require for its annexation program. The second being that MSD take over the interceptor system and give the municipalities a timetable to perform their own collector system rehab. Lengthy discussion followed. Mr. Aceto asked each Board member to get on the agenda for the next meeting of their constituted Board, to present the Sewer System Consolidation options to each constituted Board.
