## **JOB DUTIES:**

Under limited supervision, performs supervisory and technical work in the inspection of large and/or complex sanitary sewer utility construction, and related facilities to enforce District standards, approved plans and specifications in areas of new construction and existing structures concerning the sewerage district. The employee reviews and studies building code regulations to stay abreast of all changes and is required to exercise considerable independent judgment in applying standards to a variety of work situations. Reports to the Lead Construction Inspector or Director of Construction and works closely with District Engineering Staff.

## **MINIMUM TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE**

- An Associate Degree in Civil Engineering Design, Construction Technology or Construction Management **and** at least 5 years of experience in Civil Construction including Heavy Utility Construction *or any combination of training and experience which provides the required skills, knowledge and abilities.*
- Must have knowledge of approved construction practices, material and equipment, as well as Federal, State and local safety rules and regulations.
